**Notice of Race & Sailing Instructions Addendum to
BIYC Notice of Race and SI's for Spring Quartet Series Race 4 Only**

Eagle Harbour Yacht Club Invitational Race

Sunday, April 24, 2016

10:30am

1. Registration & Rules

All aspects of the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions as published on the BIYC website apply to this EHYC Invitational Race with the following changes.

2. Notice of Race

Course

The start line will be defined between a committee boat and an anchored yellow tetrahedron **"S"** located off Grebe Islets outside Eagle Harbour.

The finish line will be the imaginary line between the northern end of the club breakwater (leave to port) and the tip of land ("The Griffith's House") adjacent to Grebe Islets (leave to starboard). Finish signal horn and radio notice on Channel 73 will be given for each yacht from the clubhouse deck.

Course marks will be defined by Passage Island **"P"**, Bird Islet including the light post **"B"**, and the Start Pin **"S"**. The direction of the course will depend on wind direction and will be determined by the race committee prior to the start of the race.

The standard race course is:

Start line leaving **"S"** to port; all of the following to port in the following order **"B", "P", "S", "B"**; Finish line.



If Code Flag Romeo (Red with yellow cross) is displayed on the committee boat, the course will be:

Start Line leaving "S" to starboard; all of the following to starboard in the following order "P", "B", "S", "B"; Finish Line.

The designated course will be sailed completely, unless shortened by race officers.

3. Sailing Instructions

Course, Start & Finish

See above comments in paragraph 2 – Notice of Race

Start Sequence

Numeral 1 Pennant will replace the BIYC Burgee.

Postponement

The race committee may decide to postpone the start of the race, signaled by displaying code flag "AP" and 2 horn blasts. Start sequence will recommence one minute after "AP" is removed accompanied by 1 horn blast. Code flag "AP" and "A" with 2 horn blasts indicate the race is cancelled for the day.

Time Limit

No finish times will be recorded after 14:00 hrs.

Yachts choosing to retire before they finish must inform the race committee on channel 73 at the earliest opportunity.

Fee

Yachts already registered for the BIYC Spring Quartet Series are automatically registered for this race.

For this single race registration, the fee is \$12.00.

4. Skippers Meeting & Safety

A skippers meeting will not be held on race day.



All competitors must have an approved PFD readily available at all times while in the vicinity of the race course.

The race committee will monitor and communicate as required on VHF Channel 73.

All yachts must check in with the race committee by hailing the committee once the committee boat has established its position, or calling on Channel 73.

5. Disclaimer of Liability

The decision to race is up to the skipper. Competitors take part in this race entirely at their own risk. EHYC and the race committee will not take any liability for material damage or personal injury as a result of taking part in this race.

6. Insurance

All participating boats must carry valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000. Proof of insurance must be carried on the boat.
